

Fit for the future

Exemplar medical centre in Stoke-on-Trent demonstrates how the local LIFTCo can work quickly and flexibly with GPs to deliver new accommodation designed to meet their needs.

Set against the background of an NHS strategic service development plan to improve primary healthcare and community services in Stoke-on-Trent, Hartshill Medical Centre and pharmacy is a GP-led project designed and developed by Prime, through partnership with local LIFTCo, Prima 200.

Serving more than 6,300 registered patients, the 800 sqm single storey centre provides new and improved accommodation to Hartshill Surgery GPs currently based in a converted residential property just 400 metres away.

The £2.6 million development is an example of how their local LIFT partnership can provide a simple and effective solution for GPs to move to new, high quality and affordable accommodation quickly.





The solution

Hartshill Medical Centre began as part of NHS Stoke on Trent's wider plans for regeneration in the area when the PCT called for expressions of interest from local GPs in need of improved premises. Keen to move to new accommodation, this presented a timely opportunity for the practice. With their case for new premises agreed by NHS Stoke on Trent and the commissioner, the GPs were put in touch with local public private partnership, Prima 200 and its specialist development partner, Prime.

Overseen by the PCT, the GPs were then able to lead the creation of a new fit-forpurpose facility, which was built within 12 months of financial close being reached. This proven approach offers GPs a simple solution, which gives them control over the creation of new healthcare buildings through a smooth and efficient Department of Health approved procurement route.

The new facility, which is built under the latest building regulations, was designed by healthcare specialists One Creative Environments Ltd (One) in consultation with Hartshill Surgery and the local community and residents' association. Regular meetings were held with the practice team, patients' forum and residents to ensure the design for the new centre would be well received in the area.



Craig Walding of One explained:

Hartshill Medical Centre has been an exciting project to work on and the final result is not just a contemporary building, but a new surgery with its own identity that has been shaped by the local community. The centre will also incorporate a number of sustainable features including solar PV panels, while maximising natural ventilation, demonstrating that we've designed the building with sustainability in mind.



The GPs from Hartshill used Prime's experience in developing healthcare buildings to ensure everything would meet the required standards and quality, whilst at the same time helping to create a purpose-built facility that was designed specifically around their needs. With the backing of the PCT. the GPs had direct contact with Prima 200's pre-approved suppliers, which avoided a lengthy NHS tendering process and ensured an efficient timetable for the planning and design stages.

The benefits

One of the most important benefits for Hartshill Surgery in using LIFTCo was that the PCT made available additional rent reimbursement so that finance for the project was in place from the beginning, subject to business case approvals, which provided greater certainty the development would go ahead.

As Stoke City Council is also a partner of Prima 200, the development team was able to work closely with its urban planning and building controls teams, as well as with other local organisations such as the Highways Agency, to allow for smoother business case development. This began with the council's swift approval of Prima 200's bid to buy the council owned land on which the centre is being built and also enabled the team to address residents' concerns about parking more readily by working through an agreement with the council directly. This relationship, combined with Prime's experience in putting together similar cases, ultimately led to the planning being submitted with no objections.

What's more, as the GPs lease the centre directly from the LIFTCo, they have more control over the future of the centre and will be able to grow their services and patient numbers to develop their business and improve patient experience. In addition, the GPs will be reimbursed, in accordance with the Regulations, for their rent through their GMS contract.

The result is a high quality facility that is tailored to the surgery's needs and will have a positive effect on community life and wellbeing.

The medical centre provides improved facilities including an onsite pharmacy and a multi-purpose room for the 6,300 patients currently registered at Hartshill Surgery, as well as allowing space for the practice to grow.
